☆Let's Talk

- SAY** Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, asked Jesus to heal his daughter. While on the way to the ruler's house, they got news that the daughter had died. But Jesus said to Jairus, "Do not fear, only believe."
- ASK** *Why did Jesus say these words to Jairus?*
- SAY** Jesus was teaching Jairus to trust him. When they got to the ruler's house, people were crying because the young girl was dead. When Jesus told them not to cry, they laughed at Jesus.
- ASK** *Why did they laugh?*
- SAY** Those people didn't know that Jesus is God and that he has power over death. Jesus told them to leave. Then he went over to where the young girl lay. Jesus held her hand and told her to get up. At his words, she became alive again.
- ASK** *How do you think Jairus and his wife felt when their daughter came back to life?*
- SAY** Jairus and his wife were very glad to see their daughter alive and well again. Jairus had come to Jesus for help and Jesus had helped him in a way that only God could. Jesus made Jairus's daughter live again. Jesus is the Lord of life!

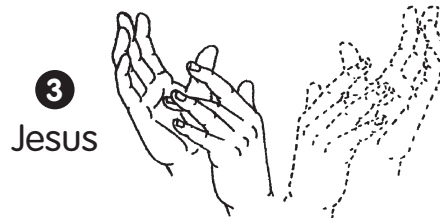
☆Let's Make
