#### **Reflection Questions:**

1. What are some of the things we learn from v1, particularly as the NT works out the implications of that verse?
2. Why is Jesus a better priest, in addition to being a better king?
3. What defeat feels overwhelming to you? Why does Jesus victory offer you hope? Think especially of how his victory starts in defeat
4. The messiah-priest-king drinks water as he's on the chase in v7. What is this image supposed to do for the reader?
5. V3 shows people flocking to Jesus in order to fight with and for him. What compels you to want more of the kingdom, to fight for the things that really matter?
